SUTTON COUNTY 2016-2017 EFFECTIVE TAX RATE

Motion was made by Commissioner Brockman, seconded by Commissioner Teaff stating "I move that the property tax rate be increased by the adoption of a tax rate of .680127, which is effectively a .04 percent increase in the tax rate. This tax rate will raise more taxes for maintenance and operations than last year's tax rate and the tax rate will effectively be raised by .04 percent and will raise taxes for maintenance and operations on a \$100,000 home by approximately \$733.74. Commissioner Teaff voted yes. Commissioner Brockman voted yes. Commissioner Villanueva voted yes. Commissioner Perez voted yes. Judge Smith voted yes. Motion carried unanimously.
