




## RESOLUTION LEVYING A TAX RATE

**BE IT RESOLVED**, by the Commissioners court of Sutton County, Texas, that on this 20<sup>th</sup> day of September 2022, a motion was made by Commissioner Carl Teaff and seconded by Commissioner Bob Brockman to increase the property tax rate to \$0.544721.

**RESOLVED BE IT FURTHER** that the undersigned do hereby vote to levy or adopt the tax rate for Sutton County General Fund for the 2022 tax year at \$0.544721 for the purpose of maintenance and operation.

**THIS TAX RATE WILL RAISE MORE TAXES FOR MAINTENANCE AND OPERTAION THAN LAST YEAR'S TAX RATE. THE TAX RATE WILL RAISE TAXES FOR MAINTENANCE AND OPERATIONS ON \$100,000 HOME BY APPROXIMATELY \$116,044.28.**


## RESOLUTION LEVYING A TAX RATE

**BE IT RESOLVED**, by the Commissioners court of Sutton County, Texas, that on this 20<sup>th</sup> day of September 2022, a motion was made by Commissioner Lee Bloodworth and seconded by Commissioner Bob Brockman to increase the property tax rate to \$0.121031.

**RESOLVED BE IT FURTHER** that the undersigned do hereby vote to levy or adopt the tax rate for Sutton County FMFC Fund for the 2022 tax year at \$0.121031 for the purpose of maintenance and operation.

**THIS TAX RATE WILL RAISE MORE TAXES FOR MAINTENANCE AND OPERAION THAN LAST YEAR'S TAX RATE. THE TAX RATE WILL RAISE TAXES FOR MAINTENANCE AND OPERATIONS ON \$100,000 HOME BY APPROXIMATELY \$28,544.60.**
